Participation independent of physical presence

Assembly Conference Voting is the solution for conducting online statutory and non-statutory elections at AGMs (Annual General Meetings), EGMs (Extraordinary General Meetings) and SGMs (Special General Meetings).

A complete conference voting system

Types of meetings Assembly Conference Voting is provided as a complete online voting solution for remote participants as well as for physically present participants.

All the activities from system configuration and invitation of participants to the practical operation and documentation of the system and system activities are included in the solution.

Based on the experience of more than 6,000 statutory and non-statutory elections, Assembly Conference Voting is designed to meet all commonly used requirements for participant validation and voting principles.

Assembly Conference Voting can be provided as a self-service solution with introduction to local administrators or as a full-service solution with an election manager from Assembly Voting.

Assembly Conference Voting is an integrated part of Assembly Voting's product universe, and can be supplemented with, for example, Assembly Candidacy for registration of candidates prior to the meeting.

Assembly Voting's data management processes are documented based on the ISAE3000 standard, ensuring that all processes are transparent and in full compliance with GDPR.

How to conduct an Assembly Conference Voting event

Invitation of participants

Participants are invited via email or SMS.

Validation of participants

Participants are validated via personal participant code or participant code and User ID.

Presentation of agenda, etc.

The conference application displays the agenda, meeting documents, ongoing elections for the participants.

System management

It is the meeting chairman who controls which pages are displayed in the conference application. Including active elections.

Amendments and new candidates

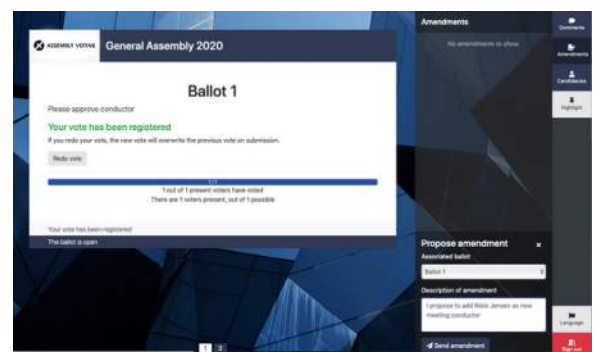
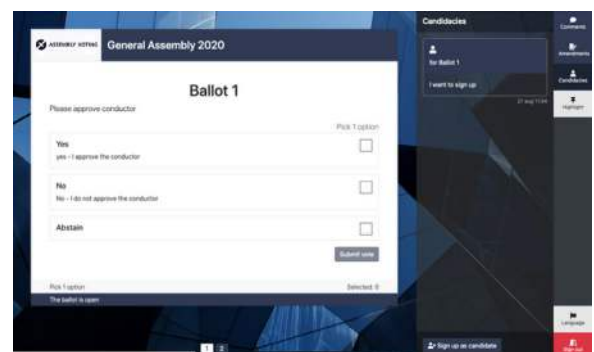
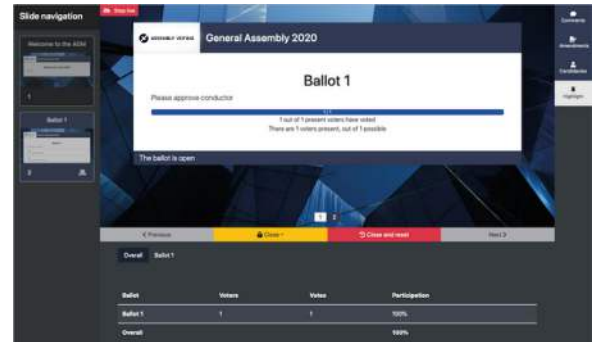
The meeting chairman can continuously add elections and supplement the ballot with, for example, newly appointed candidates.

Communication from participants

The participants can propose amendments, write comments and tell the meeting chairman that they would like to sign up as candidates.

Elections

The meeting chairman activates each election. The digital ballot is automatically displayed on the participants' conference application, incl. voting percentage and countdown to closing for voting.



Election result

Immediately after the closing of an election, the result is calculated and optionally displayed for the participants in the conference application.

Documentation

All activities during the meeting are logged in the system and are included with the election audit as documentation for the conference event.

How to setup an Assembly Conference Voting event

Data Processor Agreement (DPA)

By agreement, a mutual DPA is submitted and signed.

Specification

Validation parameters

- Invitation of participants (mail and/or SMS)
- Visual design of conference application
- Content and order of presentation pages
- Voting themes and voting principles
- Communication channels in the conference application for participants

Data

Data is transmitted in accordance with DPA and setup specification.

Configuration

Configuration of the conference application according to specifications.

Testing and approval

Conference application is reviewed, tested and approved in a demo mode before the event starts.

Start of event

Participants are invited before the start of the event, and the system shows how many participants are logged in.



Changes

New participants can be added and changes in presentation slides and elections can be made during the event. New elections can also easily be created "on the fly". All activities are logged.

Design

The conference application can be styled in accordance with the organization's "brand" when displaying the agenda, documents, election themes, options and results, etc.

Meeting Chairman

The meeting chairman can control which slides are displayed for the participants and activate the individual elections. The meeting chairman can also present the comments and questions from participants.

External Election manager

An external election manager may be available during the event to handle any changes in the system during the event.

Self-service solution

An external election manager may be available during the event to handle any changes in the system during the event.
